The residence at 237 Main Street was built in 1996 with a side gable roof. This 5 x 3 bay, wood frame, two story building is rectangular in plan and sits on a concrete foundation. The building is clad with wood clapboard on the facade and wood shingles on the side and rear elevations. The side gable roof is cevered with asphalt shingles. One brick chimney is located on the exterior, side of the house. The entrance contains a steel door with a molded surround and a transom. The windows contain 12/12 sash with molded surrounds accented with dentils. The cornerboards are thin and flat. The cornice is thin with a shallow molding. A one story side room with a recessed porch is attached to the side of this building.

Previously, a building stood on this site but it was demolished in 1993. The American Legion Post 108 occupied the previous building which was given to the Legion by the Bates Family (Caleb). The Post tried to sell the building to someone interested in restoring it but were unsuccessful. Sean Killduff purchased the building and a salvage company took most of the material from the building.

This house was built on this site in 1996. Sean and Maria Kilduff are the present owners.


