6:50 J. Hathaway and J. Hathaway Jr. relieved watch.

6:60 Female voice called on land line asking for "Karl Anderson"

Clear - bright star light - visibility good.

8:30 Cloudy - overcast north portion

9:00 cloudy - overcast north - south - west portions wind

increasing.

9:05 Moon Rises

9:25 moon Blacked out via clouds, overcast except
extreme east portion.

9:50 moon shining thru light clouds.

10:35 Moon shining no clouds except extreme east.

11:03 Bright moonlight no clouds Wind increasing in

11:25 Chief Observer Lawrence speaking over the "ground"
hookup" stated that there will be no relief
for the present watch at 12:00 AM. Therefore
the station will be closed at 12:00 AM - PM without
relief.

12:00 Station closed !!
