



**William H. Myrick
(1828-1910)**

William H. Myrick, was a tinsmith who owned a small tin shop on Summer Street, near Maple Street, where he commenced business in 1850. He sold pots, pans, buckets and other metal ware from a cart. After twenty-eight years in the business Myrick constructed a building on the corner of Summer and Evergreen Streets. The building was later moved up Evergreen Street and today is occupied by Ray Chaves, owner of Kingston Sheet Metal. Coincidentally, not long ago, the Chaves family purchased the Myrick homestead on Evergreen Street.
